Governance programmel Home Affairs - new strategy of public order and safety

Adopting a new strategy of public order and safety, focusing on an active presence of policemen on the streets, solving the staff deficit, simplifying the administration and the digital transformation of public services are some of the goals announced in the Home Affairs area, in the governance programme of the National Liberal Party - PNL, Save Romania Union - Party of Liberty, Unity and Solidarity - USR PLUS, and the Hungarian Democratic Union of Romania - UDMR coalition government.

According to the document, the Interior Ministry will define and implement, together with other state players and the aid of the civil society, a new national strategy meant to confer precise mechanisms and responsibilities in the area of public order and safety.

Its implementing will contribute to ensuring a higher level of safety for people, communities and patrimony, by eliminating prerogative overlapping among the MAI institutions, mainly the Romanian Police and the Romanian Gendarmerie, and to consolidating the mechanisms for crime prevention - through an active presence on the street segment, in the places and environments with a crime potential, in relation to the conclusions of some risk assessments that will have in view the need of security specific to each vulnerable community or group.
