Governance program: Sports complexes, ice rinks, velodromes worth 3bn euros

The new coalition, formed by the National Liberal Party, the USR-PLUS Alliance and the Hungarian Democratic Union of Romania, proposes in the governing programme the construction of hundreds of multipurpose halls, sports complexes, school sports halls, ice rinks, Olympic pools or velodromes worth a total of about 3 billion euros.

Investments in sports infrastructure throughout the country will be made in accordance with the National Plan for Investment and Economic Recovery: construction of new training and competition centres in various areas of the country carefully selected through local development strategies and integrated regional development strategies.

Also, the governing programme aims to reform the Romanian sports system by redefining the legislative framework to ensure participation, practice, performance and sports excellence.

For the position of Minister of Youth and Sports in the future government, the new coalition proposed Eduard Novak, currently president of the Romanian Cycling Federation.
