

PM Citu: Delayed projects at finance ministry; no coalition leader opposed Nazare's removal

Prime Minister Florin Citu said on Thursday, after announcing the dismissal of Alexandru Nazare from the position of finance minister, that his decision was made because there are "many" delayed projects.

"There are a lot of delayed projects, hence my decision. (...) There are projects that have an impact in the future," Citu explained after a government meeting at the Government House.

He pointed out that no leader of the ruling coalition opposed his decision.

"It is the prime minister's responsibility to make such decision. The coalition leaders have been informed, none of them have objected," the prime minister said.
