Turnover in vehicle trade up 6.3 pct, market services up 40.5 pct in first 4 months of 2022

The volume of turnover in the trade of motor vehicles and motorcycles increased, as unadjusted series, by 6.3%, in the first four months compared to the similar period of the previous year, and the volume of turnover in the market services provided to the population increased by 40.5%, according to data published on Thursday by the National Institute of Statistics (INS).

Thus, in the period January 1 - April 30, 2022, year-on-year, the volume of turnover in wholesale and retail trade, maintenance and repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles, as unadjusted series, was by 6.3% higher, influenced by the increase in turnover in: trade in car parts and accessories (+ 9.4%), trade in motorcycles, related parts and accessories, maintenance and repair of motorcycles (+ 6.5%), trade in motor vehicles (+ 5.4%) and maintenance and repair activities of motor vehicles (+ 3.9%).

From 1 January to 30 April 2022, year-on-year, the volume of turnover in wholesale and retail trade, maintenance and repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles, expressed as workday and seasonally adjusted series, increased by 4.6%.

The turnover of market services provided to the population, as unadjusted series, in the period January 1 - April 30, 2022, registered a turnover by 40.5%, year-on-year, influenced by the increase in turnover of: gambling and other recreational activities (+47.1%), activities of hotels and restaurants (+40.7%), activities of travel agencies and tour operators (+36.8%), washing and (dry) cleaning activities of textile articles and fur products (+20.5%) and hairdressing services and other beauty-related activities (+18.9%).
