

Deposits of non-government resident customers up 1.7 pct in February 2023

Deposits of non-government resident customers increased in February 2023 by 1.7% compared to the previous month, to RON 522.083 billion, according to a press release from the National Bank of Romania.

RON-denominated deposits of residents, with a share of 66.6% in total deposits of non-government clients, increased by 2.7% compared to January 2023, to RON 347.474 billion.

RON-denominated deposits of households increased by 2.2% compared to the previous month, to RON 183.377 billion.

RON-denominated deposits of other sectors (non-financial corporations and non-monetary financial institutions) increased by 3.2% (to RON 164.097 billion) compared to the previous month.

Forex-denominated deposits of residents, expressed in RON, representing 33.4% of the total volume of deposits of non-government clients, decreased by 0.3% compared to January 2023, reaching the level of RON 174.608 billion (expressed in euro, decreased by 0.2% to 35.489 billion euro).

According to BNR data, forex-denominated deposits of households, expressed in RON, decreased by 0.3% compared to January 2023, to 123.354 billion lei (expressed in euro, decreased by 0.3%, to 25.072 billion euro).

Forex-denominated deposits of other sectors, expressed in RON, decreased by 0.2% compared to January 2023, to 51.254 billion RON (expressed in euro, decreased by 0.2%, to 10.417 billion euro).
