

## Nestor Nestor Diculescu Kingston Petersen, winner of the Legal Benchmarking Group Future Lawyers Programme of the Year award



Nestor Nestor Diculescu Kingston Petersen (NNDKP) has won the Future Lawyers Programme of the Year award at the **2025 Legal Benchmarking Group Social Impact Awards**, for its programmes dedicated to future generations of legal professionals. The award reaffirms NNDKP's commitment to supporting young legal professionals, through educational initiatives adapted to their needs that combine theoretical knowledge with hands-on learning experiences, providing them with the resources and mentorship they require to develop their skills.

**Shailyn Tirado**, *Head of Research for the Social Impact Awards* shared the reasoning behind the decision to offer the award to NNDKP:

“Nestor Nestor Diculescu Kingston Petersen was awarded Future Lawyers Programme of the Year at the 2025 Legal Benchmarking Group Social Impact Awards for its programmes dedicated to future generations, recognising the firm's sustained investment in supporting and developing the next generation of legal professionals in Romania.

In 2024, the programmes engaged over 60 law students through structured academic initiatives, hands-on learning experiences across the firm's Bucharest, Cluj-Napoca and Timișoara offices, and national educational projects. By combining practical exposure, skills development, and ongoing dialogue with law students and their representative organisations, the programmes continue to create meaningful pathways into the legal profession for students from diverse backgrounds.”

“We believe that students need real support, not only formal opportunities. NNDKP's programs have grown organically, out of a desire to stay close to the younger generation and to offer them hands-on experience, mentorship, and an honest perspective on the legal profession. We see this as a natural responsibility to contribute to the development of future lawyers and to provide them with an environment in which they can learn, make mistakes and grow.
